Franklin Road Streetscape Project Update

August 17, 2020 – Nowak & Fraus Engineers, Consulting Engineer for the Village of Franklin, would like to take this opportunity to update you on the status of the improvements to your neighborhood.

Last week, the contractor team began the project on the east side of Franklin Road. Initial work included the placement of barrels and detour signage, pavement sawcutting and the start of the installation of new drainage piping.

The tasks anticipated for the week of August 17th:

- The contractor will continue with the placement of new underground piping, working from north to south.
- Complete storm drain cleaning and televising to review the condition of some of the older pipes in the downtown, to determine if any further repairs to that system are warranted.
- Work with business owners along the route to add more signage to clearly demark the route for customers.
- Poured a sample slab for review of the colored concrete proposed for use in the intersection crossings.

The Village and NFE continue to work with the Contractor team to adjust the signage to make sure motorists can clearly understand and safely navigate the detour route.
