October 26, 2020 – Nowak & Fraus Engineers, Consulting Engineer for the Village of Franklin, would like to take this opportunity to update you on the status of the improvements to your neighborhood.

Over the last week, the contractor team worked concurrently on installing new storm drain piping and electrical conduit on the west side of Franklin.

The tasks anticipated for the week of October 26th include:

- The continuation of storm drain installations, with the goal of completing that segment of the work.
- Complete placement of electrical conduit for powering new lighting.
- Continue rough grading for new curbs / sidewalks

Some upcoming information:

 A small decorative retaining "seat" wall is planned for installation on the east side of Franklin, between 14-Mile and Evelyn Court. The wall will have a split stone façade, will replace the misc. stones that line this specific area and provide pedestrians with a spot to sit as they traverse this section of walk.
