SURVEY SAYS: WOMEN CHOOSE BLUE SAPPHIRE

Women like colorful gemstones. And, according to a recent study done by the Jewelry Consumer Opinion Council, blue is their favorite color. It follows that the number one choice of colored gem purchases was blue sapphire, followed by emerald and ruby. Fourth place was shared equally by tanzanite (also blue), pink sapphire, amethyst, aquamarine and peridot. The most important factor respondents gave for choosing a piece of jewelry was gem color. In fact, when colored gems are appraised, the intensity and depth of color are most important to the gem's valuation. When choosing a piece of jewelry, look first for the quality of the gemstone and to the style of the jewelry item. The next step is to try it on for size, and to get a general feeling if it is right for you.
