# IV. ADOPTION OF MINUTES

A. Regular Meeting of June 21, 2017

# V. COUNCIL LIAISON REPORT

Creech reported on the decisions of the Village Council July 10<sup>th</sup> meeting, noting that a possible agreement with SOCCRA was discussed for hazardous waste drop off, ordinance amendment for the limit of Historic District Commission approvals, just like other commissions have, was approved and also briefly discussed the meeting between Oakland County Main Street and the Village. The former Market Basket location was discussed and the proposed Franklin Market plan has fallen apart, so a new tenant is being sought. Creech also reviewed the road construction progress. The house on the corner of Crestwood and 13 Mile Road was discussed

also, noting that the property has been seized by the federal government, and charges are pending for the property owner.

Motion by Moenck supported by Wilke to approve the amended ordinance revisions provided, for Chapter 1268 Supplementary Regulations, Section 1268.19 Excavation or Hole Requiring Construction Fencing and Chapter 1268 Supplementary Regulations Section 1268.28 Fencing Ordinance for the standards relating to Spiked Finials on Wrought Iron Fencing.

The ability of the Building Department to accept chain link fencing during a construction project, in order to prevent injuries was discussed, noting that it would be temporary and only available during actual construction until the dwelling was closed up and the lot was filled in.

Goldberg emphasized the need to adhere to Village Council's requests, and only to deliver what had been requested. Moenck discussed the possible pathways from Scenic to 13 Mile Road.

A brief discussion ensued regarding Cell Towers versus Distributed Antenna Systems (DAS) and whether or not DAS works effectively with many trees and hills such as it is in Franklin. Discussion ensued regarding the need for 200 60' poles (DAS) or one 160' foot Cell Tower. The cell phone coverage best for the entire Village, all 4 corners was discussed.
