TELEPHONE BOOKS

GLOSSY MAGAZINES & CATALOGS

- Bundle several at a time with a string or strong rubber band
- Stuff as many as you can in a paper bag and place in or next to the recycle bin for collection

BOXBOARD-CARDBOARD PAPER GROCERY BAG & TISSUE

- Cereal Boxes, shoe boxes, and similar type material NO FROZEN FOOD BOXES, NO PIZZA BOXES NO WAXED OR PLASTIC LINED BOXES
- Stuff as many at a time in a box-board box and place in or next to the recycle bin

NEWSPAPER & AD INSERTS

(INCLUDING ALL INSERTS THAT COME W/ NEWSPAPERS)

Place in brown paper bag or tuck to one side of recycling bin

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

- Fold or cut and place in seperate brown paper bag or bundle in 2 foot by 2 foot wide bundles
- Place next to recycle bin

GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

- Clear green and brown glass bottles and jars ONLY
- Rinse and TAKE LIDS OFF
- Labels are OK
- No ceramics, window glass, pyrex, lightbulbs, broken glass or drinking glasses. Bottles & jars ONLY

PLASTIC BOTTLES 23 thru 23

- Look on the bottom for a #1 thru #7 in chasing arrows
- Water bottles, milk jugs, detergent bottles, salad dressing bottles, butter tubs & personal care products
- Rinse and throw bottle caps & lids in trash Labels are OK

NO MOTOR OIL OR OTHER TOXIC FLUID CONTAINERS. NO MISC. PLASTIC TOYS

METAL CANS

- Tin, steel and aluminum cans

- Lid OFF and place inside of can - $\underline{\sf RINSE}$

JUNK MAIL/OFFICE PAPER

- White, colored paper
- Copy and notebook paper

Pick-up Schedule

Your pick-ups will generally fall around the same time each MONDAY. We will begin MONDAY ONLY collection in the Village on September 19, 2011. However, due to traffic, road conditions and volumes we may sometimes run at a different time. To ensure pick-up, please have your items at the curb **by 7:00 am or the night before your collection day.**



Place rubbish in CANS NO LARGER THAN 32-GALLONS, with lids or tied plastic bags WEIGHING NO MORE THAN 50 POUNDS EACH. Please do not put rubbish in paper bags.

Bulk Items



Large items such as furniture, appliances (including refrigeration units with Freon), mattresses, carpet, etc. will be collected on the same day with your rubbish. Place at the curb with your rubbish by 7:00 am or the night before.

NO TELEPHONE CALL IS NEEDED FOR LARGE ITEM COLLECTION. SIMPLY PLACE AT THE CURB ON COLLECTION DAY.

Please remove any doors from items before placing at the curb (for the safety of children playing near by.) Bundle all carpet in lengths of 4 feet or less and <u>weighing no more</u> <u>than 50 pounds.</u>

Holiday Schedule

ONLY IF THE HOLIDAY FALLS ON A MONDAY, YOUR COLLECTION DAY FALLS ONE DAY BEHIND.

Latex Paint

- Fill the can with kitty litter
- Leave the lid off the can(s) and allow paint to dry
- Cans will be picked up at the curb only after the paint is dry

- 32 Gallon Contatiner (Resident purchase)

Items We Do NOT Collect

- GASOLINE AND AUTOMOTIVE OIL

- •YARD WASTE MIXED WITH TRASH
- CONCRETE/BRICKS

Yard Waste Collection

Yard Waste Is: Grass Clippings, Leaves, Shrubs, Brush Trimmings and branches (UNDER 2 inches in diameter).

Yard Waste DOES NOT Include: Sod, Pet Waste, Stumps, branches OVER 2 inches in diameter, Dirt, Rocks, Trash.

> Yard Waste Collection is from the beginning of APRIL to the end of NOVEMBER

Place yard waste at the curb, 10 feet from your rubbish in the following manner:

- I. Place yard waste in designated paper yard waste bags or 20 to 32 gallon cans CLEARLY MARKED "YARD WASTE".
 Yard waste stickers are available at The Village Office. Face Sticker Toward The Street, so the driver can identify the can as yard waste. Cans over 32 gallons will not be collected due to weight. No container should weigh more than 50 pounds.
- 2. Bundle brush and branches that are 2 inches in diameter or less in 3-4 foot bundles with string. Please insure bundles are no larger than 18 inches around.

YARD WASTE MIXED WITH RUBBISH CANNOT BE COLLECTED.
